



KCKC BOAT POLICIES

(Final draft Feb 14, 2008)

SAFETY AND RESPONSIBILITY:

- Use of KCKC boats is restricted to club members in good standing.
- All members using KCKC boats must wear an approved PFD (life jacket).
- All members using KCKC boats will be required to complete an equipment/boat check in/out sheet and sign an agreement to accept responsibility for:
 - all damage to and/or loss of boat
 - all damage to and/or loss of equipment
- KCKC boats are to be used for education and club sanctioned events only.
- All members are required to share KCKC boats with other members as needed.

PRIORITY USAGE:

- First priority use will be for KCKC sponsored events.
- Secondary priority use will be for KCKC sanctioned paddles.
- Boats will be made available by a team of volunteers and be ready for use on a first come – first serve basis.

SECURITY:

- KCKC boats, related equipment and trailer will be kept in a secure storage approved by the directorate.
- During any event KCKC boats and related equipment will be kept in a separate area to maintain control of club owned property.

OUT OF TOWN USAGE:

- Users must:
 - sign a declaration stating they have taken safety courses including instruction to perform wet exits, self rescues and assisted rescues.
 - have appropriate vehicle/equipment to transport the boat safely. Compliance will be determined by the compound key holder at time of boat/equipment pick up.
 - provide a damage deposit of \$250.00 at time of booking:
 - money will be deposited into KCKC account and balance returned after check in is completed by compound key holder.
- User fee schedule:
 - pick up and return of boat and equipment: \$20.00
 - daily usage of boat and equipment: \$20.00
- KCKC boats are not available for out of town use when club events are scheduled.

MAINTENANCE FEES:

- All members using KCKC boats must pay, in advance, a nominal maintenance fee of \$10.00 per event, course or pool session;
 - KCKC may forgo the maintenance fee for special events where the boats are used for demonstration purposes.
- KCKC will reimburse members who use personal vehicles to tow the trailer to events on a per kilometer basis at a rate predetermined by the directorate.
